Dear Granville Friend:

Historic Granville will officially open the 2017 season with a yearlong theme of "1940's: A Decade of Change" – "Thanks for the Memories".

For the past seventeen years the museum has had businesses sponsor our museum, which makes it possible to operate. The cost to be a sponsor for the 2017 season is \$150.00 and entitles you to the following:

- (1) A Newsletter that will be mailed on each event to some 4,000 homes in which your business will be listed as a sponsor. This mail-out also will be done in the Spring, in the Fall and at Christmas listing you as a sponsor.

- (6) We will operate Sutton General Store each Wednesday thru Saturday plus having Sutton Old Time Music Hour each Saturday night taping great bluegrass music featuring a family style dinner by reservation (931-653-4151). Your sponsorship

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will be featured at the store as well. The store was recently chosen by Country Living Magazine as one of the 13 most charming General Stores in America. The store was featured in the Southern Living Magazine, Bluegrass Unlimited and Tennessee Farm Bureau Magazine.

During the 2016 season our attendance was over 30,000 with the Museum continuing to grow.
