The Sutton Homestead continues to greatly enhance Heritage Day, Fall Celebration and our other events. The Homestead will feature the 1880 home, Grist Mill Shop, Blacksmith Shop, Weave Shop, 1950's Gulf Garage and Antique Car Museum, 1820 Pioneer Homestead, Storytelling Shed, Entertainment Stage, Craftsmen and much more.
