B. Back Restaurant Counter

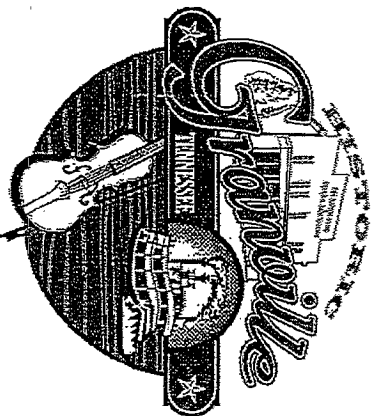
3. **Granville Museum**
